Compost Site Policy

- I. **Site Operation**
 - a. April 1 – December 1 (subject to change due to weather restrictions)
 - b. Monday|Tuesday|Thursday|Sunday: 8am-3:30pm
 - c. Wednesday|Friday|Saturday: 8am-Dusk
- II. **Allowable Users** - By utilizing the site, users agree to the terms of this policy.
 - a. Residents of the City of Silver Lake
 - b. Non-Residents through permitting system (no commercial)
- III. **Site Monitoring**
 - a. The site will be monitored continuously via a security camera system.
 - b. Users must show photo id and/or permit to gain access to site
 - c. Non-Residents must fill out log book provided at entrance for each visit
- IV. **Acceptable Material** - Materials must be separated and placed in designated areas. Load sizes must not exceed 12 yards.
 - a. Yard Waste
 - i. Grass clippings
 - ii. Leaves
 - iii. Pinecones
 - iv. Garden vegetation
 - b. Brush
 - i. Shrubs
 - ii. Twigs
 - iii. Sticks
 - iv. Tree branches up to 6 inches in diameter and less than 4 feet in length
- V. **Unacceptable Material** - This is not a comprehensive list, but rather indicates the types of material not allowed.
 - i. Construction wood
 - ii. Lumber
 - iii. Pallets
 - iv. Stumps or whole trees
 - v. Garbage including but not limited to plastic, rocks, metal, concrete, animal feces, food scraps
- VI. **Violations**
 - a. Any violation of this policy and/or illegal dumping may be prosecuted as a petty misdemeanor under MN Statute 609.68
